* Teams have to pay the additional cost of insurance per player/per day			

A team competing outside Saskatchewan must obtain permission from the Saskatchewan Soccer Association except when it applies to Canadian Soccer Association competitions. The Saskatchewan Soccer Association will communicate the approval / refusal to the district and team concerned. Traveling teams have to present the event organizer a list of all parties accompanying the team with dates of birth (youth teams only). Only teams duly affiliated with the Saskatchewan Soccer Association can obtain a travel permit. Traveling teams may only compete against opponents or in tournament matches approved by this permit and they must adhere to the rules of the competition in which they are participating. Traveling teams shall remain subject to the rules and regulations of this association are so far as disciplinary matters and behavioral conduct are concerned. The Saskatchewan Soccer Association will honor any sanction levied against players or teams on return by the player or teams to this province.



Rules and Regulations

for the Completion of

Saskatchewan Soccer Association Travel Application Form

If the team is traveling within Canada or the United States, the form must reach the Saskatchewan Soccer Association office at least thirty (30) days prior to the teams scheduled departure.

In instances where the team is traveling to a destination outside of Canada or the United States, the completed form must reach the Saskatchewan Soccer Association office at least four (4) months prior to the team's departure date!

The following Insurance Coverage is provided for players and team officials AT NO EXTRA COST:

Out-of-province anywhere in Canada, the Saskatchewan Soccer Association accident policy covers:

Accident Medical Expenses (does not include sickness)	\$10000.00
Blanket Dental Accident	\$10000.00
Accidental Death	\$15000.00

*Coverage over and above Medical Services Plan of BC and any private medical insurance plan.

Out-of-country and provided the travel is sanctioned in advance by the Saskatchewan Soccer Association the accident policy covers:

Accident Medical Expenses (including sickness)	\$2 million
Blanket Dental Accident	\$5000.00

*Coverage over and above Medical Services Plan of BC and any private medical insurance plan.

The team official listed on the form, as the contact person shall receive a copy of the form once final approval is given. A member of the team staff should take a copy of the approved form when traveling outside the province in case the affiliation status of the team is questioned.

(A copy of the approved travel form is also sent to the Association in whose jurisdiction the game, or games, are to be played.)

Any team traveling outside Saskatchewan shall be under the primary jurisdiction of its own Provincial Association and under the secondary jurisdiction of the Association in whose territory the game, or games, are to be played.

While the game or games you will be participating in will take place outside of Saskatchewan, the team and its members shall be subject to disciplinary measures taken by the Saskatchewan Soccer Association in the event that your team is reported for misconduct.

Saskatchewan Soccer Association affiliated teams should not consider entering invitational tournaments that are not approved by the provincial, State or regional association under whose jurisdiction the tournament organization group falls. Also, Saskatchewan Soccer Association member teams should not play against teams who are not properly affiliated with their respective governing body.

Saskatchewan Soccer Association Travel Policy

This policy applies to any Saskatchewan Soccer Association affiliated team wishing to play in an out-of-province tournament or to play against a team (or teams) outside of Saskatchewan. The permission to travel outside of Saskatchewan can only be granted to teams that are members in good standing with the Saskatchewan Soccer Association.

No application for the Saskatchewan Soccer Association sanctioning of a soccer instructional venture will be considered unless such application has first received the endorsement of the Saskatchewan Soccer Association member Affiliate, District, or League. The Saskatchewan Soccer Association affiliated teams shall not consider entering invitational tournaments that are not approved by the provincial, State or regional association under whose jurisdiction the tournament organizing group falls.

The Saskatchewan Soccer Association member teams shall not play against teams who are not properly affiliated directly or indirectly with their respective National, State, or Provincial governing body. Teams traveling to a sanctioned tournament have a reasonable expectation that the tournament will be run properly. If not, complaints and concerns can be addressed through the Saskatchewan Soccer Association to the tournament's sanctioning body.

Only players that are "registered or under permit" may play for your team at a sanctioned tournament. No players who are under suspension may play in tournaments and disciplinary action will be taken should a player participate in games while under suspension.

Any team applying to play outside of Saskatchewan must first submit the travel form to their youth district or senior league board for permission to travel, and secondly to the Saskatchewan Soccer Association for approval. CSA sanctioning is also required when traveling outside Canada / United States. In this instance, a fee is charged by the CSA for this service. Teams should include the fee (cheque made payable to the Saskatchewan Soccer Association) along with the completed travel form, when forwarding to the Saskatchewan Soccer Association. The Saskatchewan Soccer Association will then forward the form and fee to the CSA once provincial approval has been granted.

A member of the team staff should take a copy of the approved form when traveling outside the province in case the affiliation status of the team is questioned. Any team traveling outside Saskatchewan shall be:

- Under the primary jurisdiction of the Saskatchewan Soccer Association and under the secondary jurisdiction of the Association in whose territory the game, or games, are to be played.
- Subject to disciplinary measures taken by the Saskatchewan Soccer Association in the event that your team is reported for misconduct.
